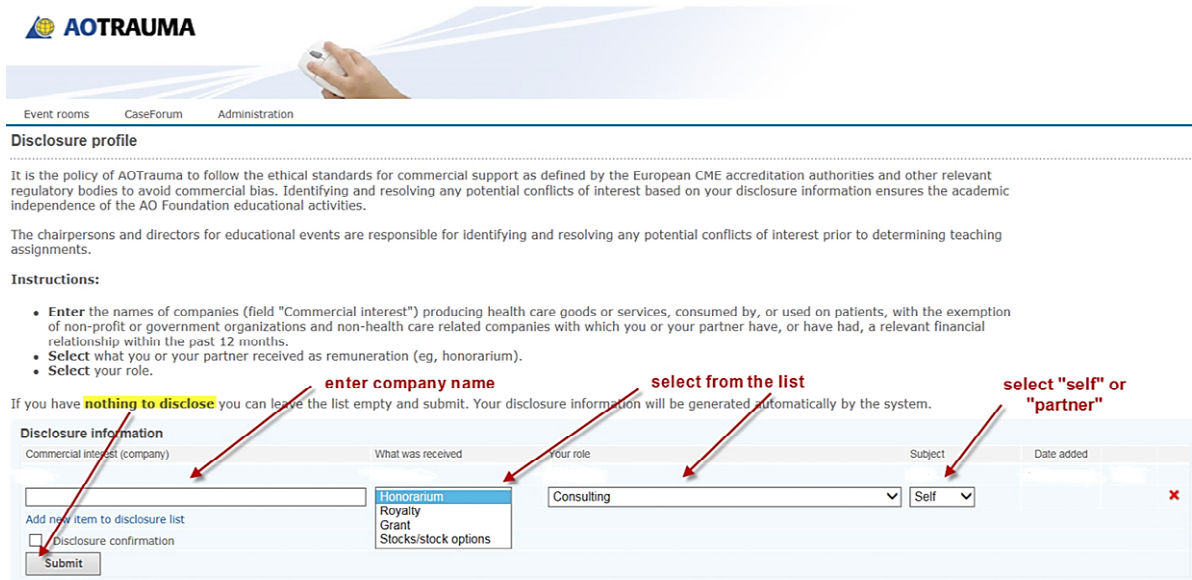

Instructions:

1. **Enter** the names of companies (field "Commercial interest") producing health care goods or services, consumed by, or used on patients, with the exemption of non-profit or government organizations and non-health care related companies with which you or your partner have, or have had, a relevant financial relationship within the past 12 months
2. **Select** what you or your partner received as remuneration (eg, honorarium)
3. **Select** your role

If you have **nothing to disclose** you can leave the list empty and submit. Your disclosure information will be generated automatically by the system.
